The Effects of Online Shopping

The world is new and ever-changing, and in today's digital world, the fast, simple acquiring of goods and services is greatly desired. At a glance, people can be seen walking with their cell phones in hand, listening to music, texting, checking their bank accounts, and even shopping. The ways of old are becoming obsolete with brick-and-mortar retailers being swallowed alive by the online giants, such as Amazon and eBay. On Monday, September 18, 2017, the popular toy-store chain in the United States of America, Toys "R"Us, filed for bankruptcy after being afflicted with a \$5 billion debt and the ever-growing online giant, Amazon. Toys "R"Us decided to close some of its under-performing stores and, in turn, expand online operations. Toys "R"Us is not the only brick-and-mortar business that suffered at the hands of online retailers; businesses such as Blockbuster, Barnes & Noble, and Walmart have all been affected by online business.

Despite its hard hit on physical businesses, online shopping has proved to have many positive advantages for consumers. Online stores are open 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, so the issue of a store closing before the consumer can make it on time is completely eliminated. Online shopping is exceptionally efficient during the holidays; shoppers do not have to bother with the long, exasperating lines, and they get to cut back on spending money on gas by staying indoors. Due to the lack of operating costs, online retailers can sell goods at lower prices; this makes the experience of online shopping not only faster and convenient, but it is also far cheaper than going to the physical store.

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Although these facts may make online shopping look like the best course of action, there are many downsides to doing online business. Back-order goods can prove to be exceedingly trying for shoppers, especially during the holidays. Shoppers also lose the person-to-person communication that an online retailer cannot provide. If issues arise during a purchase, having a human contact can resolve an issue faster and, oftentimes, more efficiently; it is also easier to be refunded as well. Online shopping is becoming an ever-growing replacement to brick-and-mortar business. This change can definitely be seen as a positive progression, but it could also prove to be a great downfall. The loss of brick-and-mortar business can render many individuals jobless; this can hurt many people financially, and job opportunities for individuals in the labor force could drop significantly.

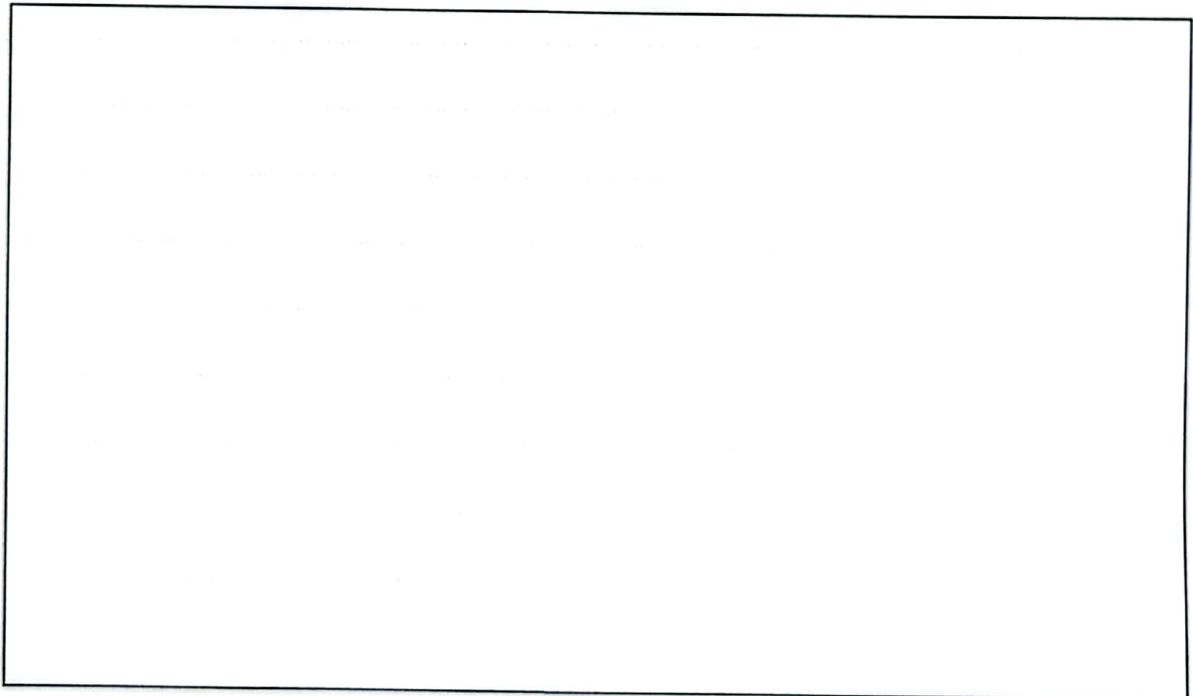
